## FIRST APPOINTMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Prior to your appointment, please complete the online patient registration form at: AdvancedOralSurgeryDubois.com

Please alert the office if you have any medical condition that may be of concern prior to surgery (i.e. bleeding disorders, heart conditions, taking blood thinners, etc.) Patients under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at the time of the initial consult and surgery.

Please bring the following with you:

- X-rays
- This referral slip
- Pertinent medical information, including a list of ALL medications
- Photo ID, medical insurance card, and dental insurance card

In most cases, sedation and surgery are not performed at the first appointment. Typically, the patient is seen first for a consultation, then the surgery is scheduled on a separate date.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR SURGERIES WITH SEDATION:

- NO FOOD OR DRINKS 8 hours prior to your surgery, including water, unless directed by your doctor.
- Most daily medications can be taken prior to surgery with only a SIP OF WATER. Plese call our office if you have any questions regaurding your medications.
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing with sleeves that can be raised to your elbow.
- YOU MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY SOMEONE TO DRIVE YOU
  HOME AFTER SURGERY (Patients under 18 must be accompanied
  by a parent or legal guardian). Once you are home, someone will
  need to stay with you for six hours.
