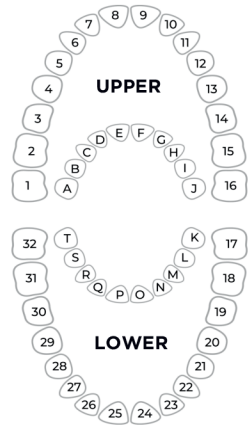

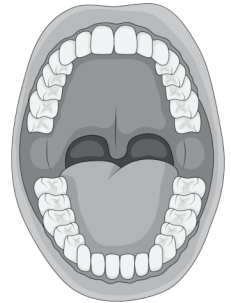

FIRST APPOINTMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Prior to your appointment, please complete the online patient registration form at: AdvancedOralSurgeryDubois.com

Please alert the office if you have any medical condition that may be of concern prior to surgery (i.e. bleeding disorders, heart conditions, taking blood thinners, etc.) **Patients under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at the time of the initial consult and surgery.**

Please bring the following with you:

- X-rays
- This referral slip
- Pertinent medical information, including a list of ALL medications
- Photo ID, medical insurance card, and dental insurance card

In most cases, sedation and surgery are not performed at the first appointment. Typically, the patient is seen first for a consultation, then the surgery is scheduled on a separate date.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SURGERIES WITH SEDATION:

- NO FOOD OR DRINKS 8 hours prior to your surgery, including water, unless directed by your doctor.
- Most daily medications can be taken prior to surgery with only a SIP OF WATER. Please call our office if you have any questions regarding your medications.
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing with sleeves that can be raised to your elbow.
- YOU MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY SOMEONE TO DRIVE YOU HOME AFTER SURGERY (Patients under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian). Once you are home, someone will need to stay with you for six hours.
